### Prayer of the Day

# Gospel Reading - Luke 2:22-40

When the time came for their purification according to the law of Moses, they brought him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord (as it is written in the law of the Lord, "Every firstborn male shall be designated as holy to the Lord"), and they offered a sacrifice according to what is stated in the law of the Lord, "a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons."

Now there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon; this man was righteous and devout, looking forward to the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit rested on him. It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Messiah. Guided by the Spirit, Simeon came into the temple; and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him what was customary under the law, Simeon took him in his arms and praised God, saying, "Master, now you are dismissing your servant in peace, according to your word; for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you have prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles and for glory to your people Israel."

And the child's father and mother were amazed at what was being said about him. Then Simeon blessed them and said to his mother Mary, "This child is destined for the falling and the rising of many in Israel, and to be a sign that will be opposed so that the inner thoughts of many will be revealed--and a sword will pierce your own soul too."

There was also a prophet, Anna the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was of a great age, having lived with her husband seven years after her marriage, then as a widow to the age of eighty-four. She never left the temple but worshiped there with fasting and prayer night and day. At that moment she came, and began to praise God and to speak about the child to all who were looking for the redemption of Jerusalem.

When they had finished everything required by the law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth. The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favour of God was upon him.

For taking the side of outcasts Reveals the inner thoughts Of those who are terrified of losing the standing They thought they had created for themselves

Opposing Jesus
For taking the side of the unclean
Reveals the inner thoughts
Of those who can't acknowledge their own brokenness

Opposing this sign
Opposing this Jesus
Says nothing about Jesus
But reveals libraries
About the ones doing the opposing

Simeon blessed them
And said to his mother Mary
"This child is destined
To be a sign
That will be opposed
So that the inner thoughts of many
Will be revealed
And a sword shall pierce your own soul, too"

Mary is not going to be immune From the pain of bearing this sign

We are not going to be immune From the pain of carrying this sign

We *too* will feel the sting
Of being confronted by this sign
Of recognizing our *own* opposition to Jesus
When we refuse to welcome those who Jesus sends to us
When we pretend that being Jesus' followers
Is only about comfort and joy
When we recognize our unwillingness to hear the stories of others
That challenge our status and our privilege

That sword of Simeon's promise
Will pierce *our* souls too
When we recognize *our* opposition to Jesus

But that piercing
That pain
Is not condemnation

It's a sign of life

A sign

An indicator

A notification

That we are alive

Alive to our real situation

Alive to our true standing

Alive to our own need

For the promise that comes

In this child

For this child

Also reveals the inner thoughts

Of the mind of God

Who loves

Who welcomes

Who forgives

Who reaches out

To the poor

To sex workers

To tax collectors

To traitors

To foreigners

To outsiders

To outcasts

To the unclean

And to us

At Christmas

And always

And forever
